





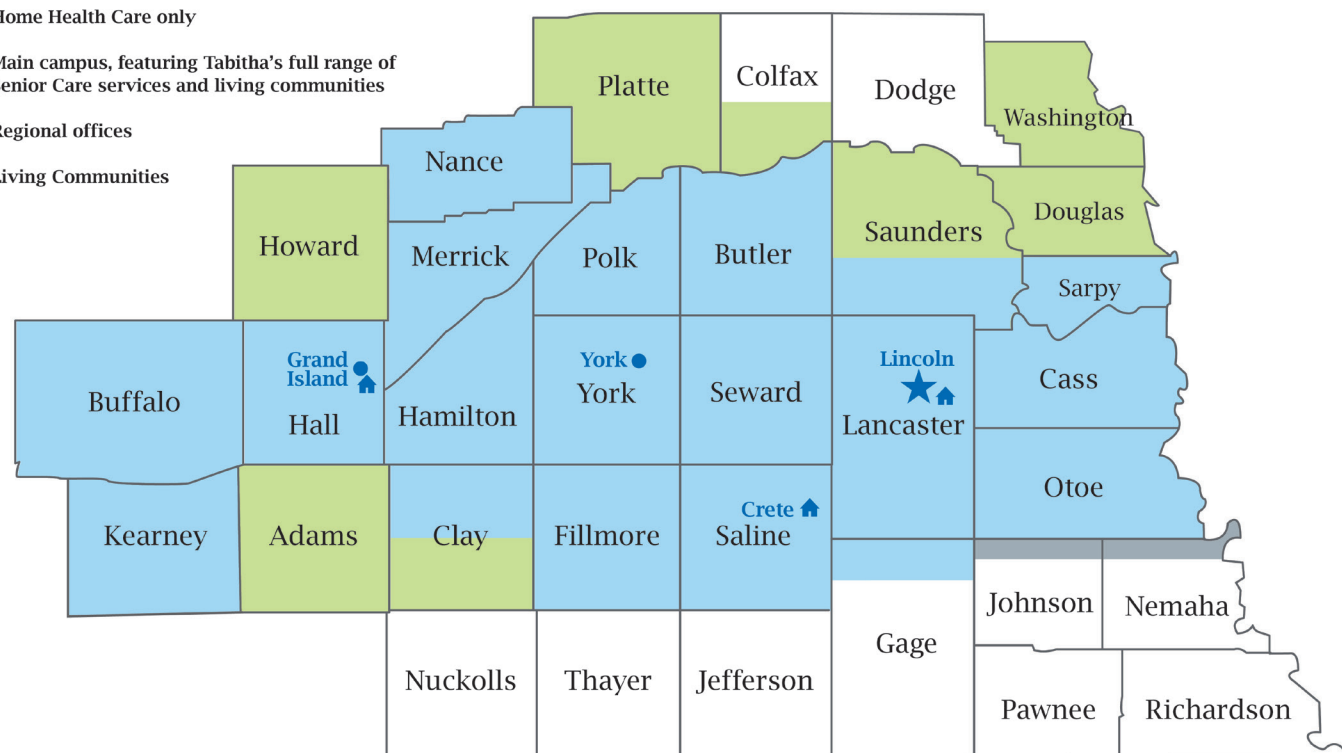

### OUR FOUNDER

*Reverend Henry Heiner, along with his wife, Emma, began Tabitha as an orphanage in 1886. He named the organization Tabitha in honor of Tabitha Katharina, one of his nine children who died in 1893—seven days after she turned two years old.*

*Equipped with a passion for reaching all those in need, Reverend Heiner and Tabitha began caring for the ill along with older adults in 1889.*

*In 1960, Tabitha completed its role as an orphanage and transitioned into dedicated older adult care, where Tabitha became—and continues to be—a proud pioneer in the industry.*

1886



**Tabitha begins as an orphanage** founded by Reverend Henry Heiner and expands to include care for the aging in 1890, and transitions to a provider for older adults in 1960.

1890



**“Old Main” is constructed** on the northwest corner of a 10-acre tract of land at 46th and Randolph to provide housing for the increasing number of resident children and adults

1966



**Tabitha Home Health Care** is one of the state’s first to provide award-winning Medicare-certified medical support wherever a client calls home.

1967



**Tabitha Meals on Wheels** Delivers a hot noon meal to Lincoln-area residents, in their homes, Monday through Friday. This lifeline service is more than just a nutritious meal; it also provides a daily safety check and friendly visit through a crew of Volunteers.

1979



**Tabitha Hospice** pioneers compassionate end-of-life care and is the longest-running program of its type in Nebraska.

1980



**Tabitha provides custom rehabilitation services** to get clients back to their lives as soon as possible.

1996



**Tabitha Residences on the main Lincoln campus** introduce Nebraska’s first and the nation’s second-of-its-kind residential-style living approach to long-term care. Good House opened in 2010, and Elizabeth and Martha Houses in 2011.

2010



**The Gardens Assisted Living in Crete** opens, providing a warm, home-like, maintenance-free setting so older adults can live life with choices and remain in a small-town community.

2011



**Journey House SNF for End-of-Life Care**, Lincoln’s only free-standing hospice community, draws on a residential care model for supporting individuals and their families at the end of life.

2011



**GracePointe Assisted Living & Memory Care Suites** is Lincoln’s premier assisted living experience, a beautifully designed, state-of-the-art community wrapped in the love and compassion of Tabitha’s renowned caregiving.

2014



**Tabitha Residences at Williamsburg** launches in the the south Lincoln Williamsburg neighborhood on Immanuel’s The Landing campus, with Tabitha Residences Cove House in 2014 and Harbor House in 2017, to offer long-term care/skilled nursing.

2016



**Tabitha Residences in Crete** are the first to bring residential-style long-term care/skilled nursing living to a rural setting in Saline County, Nebraska.

2019



**Tabitha expands into Kearney**, providing services throughout Buffalo County. Hospice services begin in 2019, followed by home health care in 2020.

2021



**James House reopens** on the Main Lincoln campus; now connected to Good House, the residence is rededicated from Martin House to James House.

2022



**Tabitha Hospice | A Collaboration with Immanuel** offers Tabitha’s compassionate care at Immanuel communities and throughout the Omaha metro area.

2022



**Tabitha at Prairie Commons** supports older adults in the Grand Island area and offers independent living, assisted living, memory care and long-term care/skilled nursing.

2023



**S<sup>2</sup>age Living By Tabitha** is an InterGenerational community that focuses on intentional neighboring and **Connections**. The first of its kind in the nation, S<sup>2</sup>age Living is home to Seniors (55+) and health sciences college students alike.

2024



**Tabitha begins an affiliation with Eventide**, a strategic partnership that marks a significant milestone for both nonprofits. The affiliation—with Eventide as the parent company—is aimed at enhancing the ability to serve Seniors across the Midwest.
