

Veterans Benefits: A Quick Guide

If you or a loved one served our country, you may have earned benefits that are worth checking out. Here are some benefits that are available, depending on eligibility:

Health Care: Medical care, prescriptions, mental health services, rehabilitation, home-based care, palliative care, and hospice services may be available.

Disability: Veterans Administration (VA) disability compensation offers a monthly tax-free payment to Veterans who got sick or injured while serving in the military and to Veterans whose service made an existing condition worse.

Careers and Employment: Apply for vocational rehabilitation services, get support for your Veteran-owned small business, and access other career resources.

Pension, and Aid & Attendance: Apply for monthly payments for wartime Veterans and survivors with limited or no income who meet certain age and disability requirements. Aid & Attendance may be added if you need help with daily activities or are housebound.

Housing Assistance: Find out if you're eligible for a VA-backed home loan. If you have a service-connected disability, see if you qualify for a housing grant to help you live more independently.

Burials and Memorials: Get help planning a burial in a VA national cemetery, order a headstone or other memorial item to honor a Veteran's service, and apply for survivor and dependent benefits.

Family and Caregivers: A spouse, dependent, survivor, or caregiver of a Veteran may be eligible for benefits such as health care, life insurance, and money for school.
